

## How to Convert a Photo to PDF on Android (Step-by-Step)

## Method 1: Using Google Photos (Pre-installed on most Android phones)

#### **Requirements:**

- Google Photos app installed (usually pre-installed)
- Photo saved on your phone

#### Steps:

- 1. Open the Google Photos app.
  - Look for the multicolored pinwheel icon named *Photos*.
  - Tap it to open.





## 2. Locate your photo.

• Scroll through the timeline or tap "Search" > "Photos" to find the image.





# 3. Tap to open the photo.

- Make sure it's the correct image you want to convert.
- 4. Tap the three-dot menu (:) in the top right corner.





- 5. Choose "Print."
  - You'll see a print preview screen with print settings.





## 6. Save PDF.

• Choose **"Save as PDF"** icon.





## 7. Choose a location to save the file.

- Pick a folder in your device or Google Drive.
- Rename the file if needed.
