All providers that provided medical care or treatment to decedent are hereby ORDERED to release decedent's medical records and medical billing records directly to _____ for the limited purpose of deciding whether or not to file a wrongful death, personal injury, or survivorship action. The medical records and medical billing records are confidential and shall not be made available for public viewing unless otherwise provided for by law or subsequent court order.

Further, upon obtaining the requested applicable records and before the expiration of the applicable statute of limitations, _____ is ORDERED to file a report with the court certifying that all requested medical records and medical billing records have been received and shall indicate whether an administration of the decedent's estate will be filed.
