STATEMENT CONCERNING COURT COSTS
(NEW GUARDIANSHIP APPOINTMENT)

An application for appointment of guardian is being filed with the court.

The court will determine whether the prospective ward has sufficient income and assets to pay the court costs associated with the application.

The court will file paperwork indicating that either:

- The prospective ward does not have enough funds to pay court costs, so the prospective ward is indigent and no court costs will be due; OR
- Court costs need to be paid before the hearing.

If court costs are due, the applicant must ensure that they are paid at least three days before the hearing.

Failure to pay court costs may result in the hearing being rescheduled or the applicant not being appointed as guardian.
