Closing a Custodial Account and Court Case when a Minor Turns 18

The steps required to close a custodial account, and the associated court case, depend on the case type:

MINOR SETTLEMENT or DISPENSE WITH GUARDIANSHIP: The court will notify the bank that the child has turned 18 and the bank will lift the restriction. The court case will automatically close.

MINOR GUARDIANSHIP: To terminate a minor guardianship of the estate, you must electronically file the following necessary paperwork:

1. Application to Terminate Guardianship (Custodial) – Form ePC-G-15.4C.
This form must be **signed by the Guardian**.
2. Proposed Entry to Terminate Guardianship (Custodial) – Form ePC-G-15.4CE
3. Receipt and Release of All Claims (Custodial) – Form ePC-G-15.4C.

This form must be **signed by the Minor** after s/he turns 18.

4. Government issued **photo identification card for the Minor**, with date of birth.

The court case will close when the Entry to Terminate Guardianship is approved.
