Legal practice in local courts is restricted by law to attorneys who are licensed by the Ohio Supreme Court. Due to the complexity of the law, most individuals who have business with the Probate Court are represented by an attorney. Court employees are prohibited by statute from practicing law and cannot give legal advice.
